ORDINANCE NO. 2013-O-007

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE OF BURNHAM ORDINANCE NO. 2012-O-006 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS, APPOINTED OFFICIALS, LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSIONER, MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BURNHAM, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, (the “Village”) has elected by Referendum on March 11, 1980 to become a home rule unit, and accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, particularly Article VII, Section 6(a) thereof, the Village is a home rule unit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers of a home rule unit set forth in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of public health, safety, morals, and welfare, to license, to tax and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village passed on September 25, 2012 and Village President (Mayor) Robert E. Polk approved on October 1, 2012 Village of Burnham Ordinance No. 2012-O-006, entitled An Ordinance Establishing The Salaries Of Elected Officials, Appointed Officials, Local Liquor

Control Commissioner, Members Of The Police Department, Members Of The Fire Department, and Other Employees Of The Village Of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois ("Ordinance No. 2012-O-006"); and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village deem it advised to increase that the annual salary of the Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village deem it advised to establish the compensation of the Building Commissioner and the Custodian for the Village Hall, Community Center, and Senior Center.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President (Mayor) and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preambles of this Ordinance are true, correct and complete and do hereby incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. SECTION 5. of Ordinance No. 2012-O-006 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Compensation of Village Treasurer.

The Treasurer of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of **Forty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Forty and**

No/100 Dollars (\$47,840.00) payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments."

Section 3. SECTION 16. of Ordinance No. 2012-O-006 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 16. Compensation of Other Village Employee.

Each employee of the Village of Burnham shall receive the following specified amounts as compensation for his/her respective position for the performance of his/her duties payable in twenty-six (26) installments:

Laborer Supervisor in Garbage Department	\$ 18.25 per hour
Laborer in Garbage Department	\$ 16.48 per hour

Laborer in Sewer/Water Department	\$ 16.48 per hour
Water Meter Installer	\$ 29.61 per meter
Water Meter Reader for Convalescent Home and Calumet Lubricants for the months of November thru March, inclusive	\$ 44.35 per month
Water Meter Reader for Convalescent Home and Calumet Lubricants for the months of April thru October, inclusive	\$ 64.01 per month
Water Department Billing Clerk	\$ 17.75 per hour
Water Meter Reader for Route 1	\$ 496.00 per quarter reading
Water Meter Reader for Route 2A	\$ 258.00 per quarter reading
Water Meter Reader for Route 2B	\$ 422.00 per quarter reading
Water Meter Reader for Route 3	\$ 437.00 per quarter reading
Sewer Lift Station Operator	\$ 612.00 per month
Recording Secretary of Board of Fire and Police Commission	\$ 104.00 per month"

Section 4. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be separable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, provision or part shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the Courts, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance nor any part thereof, other than the part declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Section 7. This Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such Ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or, (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a manner not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any no-preemptive state law, that this Ordinance should supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the Village President (Mayor) and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois.
