AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS, APPOINTED OFFICIALS, LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSIONER, MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BURNHAM, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, (the "Village") has elected by referendum on March 11, 1980 to become a home rule unit, and, accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, particularly, Article VII, Section 6 (a) thereof, the Village is a home rule unit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers of a home rule unit set forth in Article VII, Section 6 (a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license; to tax; and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village deem it advisable to increase the compensation received by elected officials, appointed officials, local liquor control commissioner, members of the Police Department, members of the Fire Department, and other employees of the Village for the performance of their duties; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village deem it advisable to establish the compensation received by the Superintendent of Public Works, Members of the Police Department, Employees of the Public Works Department, and Secretary with 400 hours of continued employment in the Village Clerk's office for the performance of their duties on a seniority basis.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1. Compensation of Village President.

a. The President of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Three Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$3,300.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month. Also, the Village President shall be compensated in an amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham actually attended.

b. In addition, the President of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual allowance of Five Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$5,100.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month for expenses incurred by the Village President in the course of his official duties. Said allowance shall include but not be limited to gasoline, entertainment, stationery and supplies, postage, membership dues, subscriptions and publications, conventions, conferences and other sundry expenses incurred in the course of his official duties.

SECTION 2. Compensation of Village Trustee.

a. Each Trustee of the Village of Burnham shall receive as compensation the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$2,220.00) annually payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month. In addition, each Trustee shall be compensated in an amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham actually attended.

b. In addition, each Trustee of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual allowance of Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month for expenses incurred

by each Village Trustee in the course of his/her official duties. Said allowance shall include but not be limited to gasoline, entertainment, stationery and supplies, postage, membership dues, subscriptions and publications, conventions, conferences and other sundry expenses incurred in the course of his/her official duties.

SECTION 3. Compensation of Village Clerk.

a. The Clerk of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Twenty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$27,300.00) payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments. Also, the Village Clerk shall be compensated in an amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham actually attended.

b. In addition, the Village Clerk of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual allowance of Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200.00) payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments for expenses incurred by the Village Clerk in the course of his/her official duties. Said allowance shall include but not be limited to gasoline, entertainment, stationery and supplies, postage, membership dues, subscriptions and publications, conventions, conferences and other sundry expenses incurred in the course of his/her official duties.

SECTION 4. Compensation of Village Collector.

The Village Collector of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,600.00 payable in Twenty-six (26) equal installments.

SECTION 5. Compensation of Village Treasurer.

The Treasurer of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$7,280.00) payable in twelve (26) equal monthly installments.

SECTION 6. Compensation of Superintendent of Public Works.

The Superintendent of Public Works of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual base salary of Fifty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$57,865.00) payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments.

In addition, the Superintendent of Public Works shall receive a seniority stipend as follows:

- (a) After the fourth (4th) year of continued employment from the date of full time employment until the eighth (8th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,020.00 per year
- (b) Eighth (8th) year of continued employment until the twelfth (12th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,540.00 per year
- (c) Twelfth (12th) year of continued employment until the sixteenth (16th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 2,060.00 per year
- (d) Sixteenth (16th) year of continued employment until the twentieth (20th) anniversary date of full time employment-----\$ 2,580.00 per year
- (e) Twentieth (20th) year of continued employment until the twenty-fifth (25th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 3,600.00 per year
- (f) Twenty-fifth (25th) year of continued employment until the thirtieth (30th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 4,120.00 per year
- (g) Thirtieth (30th) year of continued employment after day of full time employment and over-----\$ 5,140.00 per year

SECTION 7. Compensation of Water Works Engineer.

The Water Works Engineer of the Village of Burnham shall receive Twenty-Two Dollars an hour payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments.

SECTION 8. Compensation of Local Liquor Control Commissioner.

The Local Control Commissioner of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,520.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month.

SECTION 9. Compensation of Board of Local Improvements.

Each member of the Board of Local Improvements of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month.

SECTION 10. Compensation of Members of Police Department.

The first paragraph of Section 12 of Ordinance No. 61-O-109 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing A Police Department In The Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, As Amended, "beginning with the word "Members" and ending with the word "day" is hereby deleted and in lieu thereof the following is inserted:

SECTION 12. (Compensation)

"Members of the Police Department shall receive the following specified amounts as base compensation for the performance of their duties:

Chief of Police -----	\$ 73,170.00 per year
Captain -----	\$ 67,005.00 per year
Lieutenant -----	\$ 62,270.00 per year

Sergeant -----	\$ 58,214.00 per year
Patrolman-Supervisor -----	\$ 56,524.00 per year
Patrolman -----	\$ 52,842.00 per year
Probationary Patrolman -----	\$ 42,239.00 per year
Radio Operator -----	\$ 35,594.00 per year
Probationary Radio Operator -----	\$ 31,896.00 per year
Administrative Assistant -----	\$ 39,000.00 per year
Part Time Supervisor Patrolman -----	\$ 15.75 per hour
Part-Time Patrolman -----	\$ 14.50 per hour
Part-Time Radio Operator -----	\$ 13.00 per hour
Crossing Guard -----	\$ 27.25 per day

In addition, a Chief of Police, Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant, and Patrolman shall receive a seniority stipend as follows:

- (a) After the Fourth (4th) year of continued employment from the date of full time employment until the eighth (8th) anniversary date of full time employment-- -----\$ 1,020.00 per year
- (b) Eighth (8th) year of continued employment until the twelfth (12th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,540.00 per year
- (c) Twelfth (12th) year of continued employment until the sixteenth (16th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 2,060.00 per year
- (d) Sixteenth (16th) year of continued employment until the twentieth (20th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 2,580.00 per year
- (e) Twentieth (20th) year of continued employment until the twenty-fifth (25th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 3,600.00 per year

- (f) Twenty-fifth (25th) year of continued employment until the thirtieth (30th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 4,120.00 per year
- (g) Thirtieth (30th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment and over- -----\$ 5,140.00 per year

In addition, a radio operator shall receive a seniority stipend as follows:

- (a) After the Fifth (5th) year of continued employment from the date of full time employment until the tenth (10th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,220.00 per year
- (b) Tenth (10th) year of continued employment until the fifteenth (15th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,740.00 per year
- (c) Fifteenth (15th) year of continued employment until the twentieth (20th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 2,480.00 per year
- (d) Twentieth (20th) year of continued employment until the twenty-fifth (25th) anniversary date of full time employment ----- \$ 3,600.00 per year
- (e) Twenty-fifth (25th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment-----\$ 4,120.00 per year
- (f) Thirtieth (30th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment and over-----\$ 5,140.00 per year

As additional compensation, each member of the Police Department, except the Chief of Police, shall receive a sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for each court hearing actually attended by each said police officer and the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) for each bond hearing actually attended by each said police officer, except the Chief of Police.

SECTION 11. Compensation of Members of Fire Department.

The Chief of the Fire Department of the Village of Burnham and each member of the Village Volunteer Fire Department of the Village of Burnham shall receive a sum of Fifteen Dollars and .00/100 (\$15.80) for each fire or ambulance call actually attended by the said Chief of said Fire Department or by each said member of the Volunteer Fire Department.

The Chief of the Fire Department of the Village of Burnham shall also receive an annual salary of Five Thousand Five-Hundred-Twenty Dollars (\$5,520.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month for administrative services.

In addition, the Chief of the Fire Department of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual allowance of One Thousand Four-Hundred-Forty Dollars (\$1,440.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month for expenses incurred by the Chief of the Fire Department in the course of his official duties. Said allowance shall include but not be limited to gasoline, entertainment, stationery and supplies, postage, membership dues, subscriptions and publications, conventions, conferences and other sundry expenses incurred in the course of his official duties.

The custodian of the Fire Station shall receive an annual salary of One Thousand Nine- Hundred-Eighty Dollars (\$1,980.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month.

SECTION 12. Compensation of Code Enforcement Officer.

The Code Enforcement Officer of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Four Thousand Seven-Hundred-Four Dollars (\$5,088.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month.

SECTION 13. Allowance for Director of Emergency Services and Disaster Department.

The Director of Emergency Services and Disaster Department of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual allowance of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month for expenses incurred by said Director of Emergency Services and Disaster Department in the course of his official duties. Such allowance shall include but not be limited to gasoline, entertainment, stationery and supplies, postage, membership dues, subscriptions and publications, conventions, conferences and other sundry expenses incurred in the course of his official duties.

SECTION 14. Compensation of Employees of Public Works.

Each laborer in the Public Works Department of the Village of Burnham shall receive a sum of \$18.79 per hour as base compensation for the performance of his/her duties payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments.

In addition, each laborer in the Public Works Department shall receive a seniority stipend as follows:

- (a) After the Fourth (4th) year of continued employment from the date of full time employment until the eighth (8th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 1,020.00 per year

- (b) Eighth (8th) year of continued employment
until the twelfth (12) anniversary date of
full time employment -----\$ 1,540.00 per year
- (c) Twelfth (12th) year of continued employment
until the sixteenth (16th) anniversary date of
full time employment -----\$ 2,060.00 per year
- (d) Sixteenth (16th) year of continued employment
until the twentieth (20th) anniversary date of
full time employment -----\$ 2,580.00 per year
- (e) Twentieth (20th) year of continued employment
after date of full time employment -----\$ 3,600.00 per year
- (f) Twenty-fifth (25th) year of continued employment
after date of full time employment -----\$ 4,120.00 per year
- (g) Thirtieth (30th) year of continued employment
after date of full time employment and over-----\$ 5,140.00 per year

SECTION 15. Compensation of Secretary With Over 400 Hours of Continued
Employment in Village Clerk's Office.

A secretary with 400 hours of continued employment in the Village Clerk's Office shall receive a sum of \$17.75 per hour as base compensation for the performance of his/her duties payable in twenty-six installments.

In addition, a secretary/collector with 400 hours of continued employment in the Village Clerk's Office shall receive a seniority stipend as follows:

- (a) After the Fourth (4th) year of continued
employment from the date of full time
employment until the eighth (8th)
anniversary date of full time employment-----\$ 1,020.00 per year
- (b) Eighth (8th) year of continued employment
until the twelfth (12th) anniversary date of
full time employment -----\$ 1,540.00 per year
- (c) Twelfth (12th) year of continued employment
until the sixteenth (16th) anniversary date
of full time employment -----\$ 2,060.00 per year

- (d) Sixteenth (16th) year of continued employment until the twentieth (20th) anniversary date of full time employment -----\$ 2,580.00 per year
- (e) Twentieth (20th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment -----\$ 3,600.00 per year
- (f) Twenty-fifth (25th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment ----- \$ 4,120.00 per year
- (g) Thirtieth (30th) year of continued employment after date of full time employment and over -----\$ 5,140.00 per year

SECTION 16. Compensation of Other Village Employees.

Each employee of the Village of Burnham shall receive the following specified amounts as compensation for his/her respective position for the performance of his/her duties payable in twenty-six (26) equal installments.

SECTION 17. Repeal.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 18. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, according to the law, retroactive from May 1, 2012. However, the salary as specified in Section 1a., Section 2a., Section 3a., Section 8, or Section 9 is not applicable during the current term of the person holding said office on the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION 19. Legislation Act.

This Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a matter or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham that to the extent that the terms of this ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state

law, that this Ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 20. Pamphlet Form.

This Ordinance shall be published by printing in pamphlet form by the authority of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois.
