Vehicle stickers for 2021-2022 are now on sale. You have the following options in order to purchase your vehicle sticker(s). There is a \$35.00 fee for any returned payments. Please follow the instructions below:

In-Person: Bring a copy of your current vehicle registration(s) If you are a senior, provide your ID for proof of your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, bring your Military ID number.

By Email: Email your current vehicle registration(s) showing your name and address to vehiclestickers@burnhamil.gov. Include in the email your name, address, phone number, and number of stickers needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you.

By Night Drop - located inside Village Hall: Place a copy of your current vehicle registration(s) showing your name and address into the night drop box inside Village Hall. Include your name, address, phone number and the number of sticker(s) needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you.

By Mail: Mail a copy of your current vehicle registration(s) showing your name and address to Village of Burnham, 14450 S. Manistee Avenue, Burnham, IL 60633. Include your name, address, phone number and the number of sticker(s) needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you.

YARD WASTE:

Yard Waste pickup will be from April 6th through November 30th. Yard Waste must be in degradable paper bags **or** waste containers made of a durable metal or plastic, nonabsorbent, water tight and easily washable container not exceeding 32 gallons or 45 pounds in capacity which has a close fitting cover and has at least two suitable handles to facilitate collection, and to which a "Yard Waste Only" (supplied by the Village) sticker is affixed. Tree cuttings and branches shall be bundled securely in lengths not to exceed four (4) feet, no more than four (4) inches in diameter and heights not to exceed two (2) feet. The weight of any bundled refuse shall not exceed forty-five (45) pounds. There is no fee for the Yard Waste sticker.

LEAF COLLECTION:

Leaf collection begins in the fall-as needed. Please rake leaves to the parkway and remove any debris that may cause harm to our workers or damage the equipment.

HEAVY PICK UP:

Homewood Disposal Service, Inc. will pick up weekly on Monday; **ONE bulk item each week.** One large item of furniture or one household appliance. Items that will not be collected: No TVs, engine blocks, tires, transmissions, axles, heavy metal parts, broken concrete, stone, clay, dirt, metal, swimming pools, electronic waste or refuse resulting from building construction or material. UNKEPT PROPERTIES

Please maintain your lawns, parkways, alleys and keep the area behind your garage cut and cleaned. Enforcement Citations will be issued for unkept properties. Please keep grass clippings off the street and away from the curb drains.

GARBAGE CANS:

No other containers can be used. Garbage cannot be left on the ground. Enforcement Citations will be issued. Closed garbage lids prevents rainwater collecting which can lead to mosquitoes, and helps prevent animals from getting into the garbage.

BUILDING PERMITS:

A Building Permit must be obtained prior to any home improvements, additions or construction. Permit applications can be found on the Village website.

LIBRARY CARDS:

The Village of Burnham does not have a Library. Library Cards can be purchased from the Calumet City Library or the Hammond Public Library. The Village of Burnham will reimburse its residents after purchase with a paid receipt.

COMMUNITY CENTER:

Re-opening July 1, 2021. Community Center located at 14020 Torrence Avenue. Hours are Tuesdays & Thursdays 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

STREET & ALLEY LIGHTS:

Metal light poles are serviced by the Village, call the Village with the address. Wooden light poles are serviced by ComEd 800-334-7661.

GUTTERS & SUMP PUMPS:

Please direct any water discharged from gutters and sump pumps to your own property. Water from gutters and sump pumps should **not** flow onto Village property.

DOG OWNERS:

Dog waste endangers the health of our children, transmits disease and devalues our Village. Dog walkers must clean-up their dog's waste and have a current Pet Tag. Signs will be posted throughout the Village. Citations will be issued for non-compliance. All pets require current rabies vaccinations.
