The Village of Burnham appreciates our new residents and new property owners. Burnham residents, let's extend a warm welcome to our new neighbors with a smile and a friendly Hello.

Public Works will plow curb to curb, *if the vehicles are moved*. Please we are asking our residents to observe the following – *Snow Tips*:

- > Remove all inoperable vehicles from the streets
- > Do not shovel snow onto the streets
- Do not clear your driveway until after the snowplow has plowed in front of your residence
- > No items are to be placed on the street to "reserve" a parking area (i.e.chairs, buckets, etc.)

Let's be mindful of our residents, especially our seniors, handicapped, and homebound residents who live alone. The winter and snow can be challenging. Neighbors, please offer to assist them with snow removal. Hopefully, this will help in case they have doctor visits, etc.

It is very important in the event of an emergency the fire hydrants are visible and accessible. If you have a fire hydrant on your parkway or nearby, please clear the snow around the fire hydrant.
