Vehicle stickers for 2022-2023 are now on sale. You have the following options in order to purchase your vehicle sticker(s). There is a \$35.00 fee for any returned payments. Please follow the instructions below:

In-Person: Bring a copy of your current vehicle registration(s) If you are a senior, provide your ID for proof of your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, bring your Military ID number. The office accepts Cash, Check, Money Order, payable to: Village of Burnham, Visa or MasterCard payments. Office hours: Monday thru Friday 9:00 am – 5:00 pm.

By Email: Email your current vehicle registration(s) showing all the required information listed above to <u>vehiclestickers@burnham-il.gov</u>. Include in the email your name, address, phone number, and number of stickers needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you.

By Night Drop – located inside Village Hall: Place a *copy* of your current vehicle registration(s) showing all the required information listed above in night drop box inside Village Hall. Include your name, address, phone number and the number of sticker(s) needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, or you can include a check/money order payable to: Village of Burnham and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you – *PLEASE DO NOT PLACE ANY CASH IN THE NIGHT DROP**

By Mail: Mail a *copy* of your current vehicle registration(s) showing the required information listed above to: Village of Burnham, 14450 S. Manistee Avenue, Burnham, IL 60633. Include your name, address, phone number and the number of sticker(s) needed. If you are a senior, include your date of birth, and if you are a veteran, include your Military ID number. You will be contacted at the phone number provided and payment can be made by phone with either a Visa or MasterCard, or you can include a check/money order payable to: Village of Burnham and your vehicle sticker(s) will be mailed to you. *PLEASE DO NOT MAIL ANY CASH**

- YARD WASTE:Refuge collection day is every Monday. If a holiday falls on a Monday, the collection day will
be the next business day. Yard Waste Season is April 1st to November 30th. By Illinois state
law, yard waste cannot be disposed of with regular garbage. Yard waste will be picked up
on regularly scheduled garbage days. Yard waste can be placed in brown paper yard waste
bags or in yard waste carts with a "Yard Waste Only" sticker. "Yard Waste Only" sticker
(available at Village Hall Clerk's Office at no charge). Yard waste bags and containers
cannot exceed 50 pounds and should be able to be reasonably lifted by one person. Bundled
and tied branches should be cut to 3-4 foot lengths
- **HEAVY PICK UP:** Homewood Disposal Service, Inc. will pick up weekly on Monday; **ONE bulk item each week.** One large item of furniture or one household appliance. Items that will not be collected: No TVs, engine blocks, tires, transmissions, axles, heavy metal parts, broken concrete, stone, clay, dirt, metal, swimming pools, electronic waste or refuse resulting from building construction or material. - **LEAF COLLECTION:** Leaf collection begins in the fall-as needed. Please rake leaves to the parkway and remove any debris that may cause harm to our workers or damage the equipment.
- UNKEPTPlease maintain your lawns, parkways, alleys and keep the area behind your garage cutPROPERTIESand cleaned. Enforcement Citations will be issued for unkept properties. Please keep grass
clippings off the street and away from the curb drains.
- **GARBAGE CANS**: No other containers can be used. Garbage cannot be left on the ground. Enforcement Citations will be issued. Close garbage lids to prevent rainwater collecting which can lead to mosquitoes, and helps prevent animals from getting into the garbage.
- **BUILDING PERMITS:** A Building Permit must be obtained prior to any home improvements, additions or construction. Permit applications can be found on the Village website.
- LIBRARY CARDS: Residents of the town of Burnham may obtain a library card at the Calumet City Public Library. The library will issue the library card to the individual and then directly bill the Village of Burnham for an annual fee of \$100. Burnham residents will be subject to the same rules and regulations regarding application and proof of residence as outlined in Resident Cards. - GUTTERS & SUMPPlease direct any water discharged from gutters and sump pumps to your own property.PUMPS:Water from gutters and sump pumps should *not* flow onto Village property.
- **DOG OWNERS**: As a responsible Pet Owner, clean up after your pet. Pets outside your property should be on a leash. Dog waste endangers the health of our children, transmits disease and devalues our Village. Dog walkers must clean-up their dog's waste. Signs will be posted throughout the Village. Citations will be issued for non-compliance. All pets require current rabies vaccinations and a Pet Tag.
