

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-O-001

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND ADOPTING FEES TO BE
CHARGED FOR FIRE, RESCUE, AND FIRE DEPARTMENT
SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE VILLAGE OF BURNHAM FIRE
DEPARTMENT, BY AMENDING AND ADDING ARTICLE 6-FIRE,
RESCUE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICE FEES TO CHAPTER
38-FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF BURNHAM, COOK COUNTY,
ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Burnham was organized as a municipal corporation on February 8, 1907, by court order under the Cities, Villages, and Towns Act of the Illinois Revised Statutes in Cook County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, has elected by referendum on March 11, 1980, to become a home rule unit, and accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, particularly Article VII Sec. 6 (a) thereof, the Village is a home rule unit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers of a home rule unit set forth in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare, to license, to tax, and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Burnham through its Fire Department provides various fire, rescue and emergency services to individuals (residents and non-residents) and to properties (residential, commercial, and personal property); and

WHEREAS, the general tax revenues are insufficient to offset the costs of providing the manpower and maintaining the equipment for these services; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham have deemed it necessary, essential and in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Burnham, and for the public interest, safety, and welfare to authorize, to approve, to establish and to charge fees for providing and maintaining fire department services to both recipients and their respective health, homeowners, and automobile insurance companies; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham have deemed it necessary, essential and in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Burnham, and for the public interest, safety, and welfare to provide for the invoicing and processing of such fees provided by the Village of Burnham Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Central Billing Solutions, LLC, existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, has proposed and is able to implement a process for invoicing and processing the fees for such services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village President (Mayor) and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLES

THAT, the Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find that all the recitals contained in the preambles of this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference as if they were set forth verbatim in this section; and

Section 2. SCHEDULE OF FEES ADOPTED

THAT, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham hereby approve, establish, and adopt the charges and fees which are to be imposed, charged, and processed for the various forms of fire, rescue, and emergency services performed by the Village of Burnham Fire Department as more fully set forth in the attached schedule of fees identified as **Exhibit A** and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 3. ADDITION OF ARTICLE 6 - FEES

THAT, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Burnham Chapter 38-Fire Prevention and Protection by adding Article 6-Fire, Rescue and Fire Department Service Fees as follows:

Section 38-206 Fire Department Service Fees- that, the person, persons or entities as set forth in Section 38-203-Liability for Costs, shall be responsible for payment of the charges and fees as set forth in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 4. RELEASE OF INFORMATION AND REPORTS

THAT, in order to facilitate the process of invoicing and processing the fees for fire, rescue and emergency services, the Village Clerk, the Police Department and Fire Department and their respective staffs are authorized to release information and copies of their records and reports to Central Billing Solutions, LLC.

Section 5. INVOICE PROCESS AND PROCEDURES

THAT, the invoice procedure shall include the recipient of such services and his, her or its respective insurance company.

Charges for Fire Department services shall be billed as follows:

- 1) When Fire Department services are rendered by the Village of Burnham to residents, such person shall not be billed for the remaining charges which may exist once final payment has been received from all insurance providers of the resident.
- 2) When Fire Department services are rendered by the Village of Burnham to non-residents or commercial entities, such persons or commercial entities shall be billed for the remaining charges which may exist once final payment has been received from all insurance providers of the non-resident.
- 3) Except for commercial entities, no bonafide Village of Burnham human resident shall be financially responsible for any balance outstanding above all insurance company's payments.

Section 6. CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL BILLING, LLC

THAT, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham hereby approve and authorize the Village President (Mayor) to execute an agreement and the Village Clerk is authorized to attest to said agreement to be formalized along the written proposal of dated December 6th, 2022, presented by Central Billing Solutions, LLC.

Section 7. PROCEEDS INTO CORPORATE ACCOUNT

THAT, all fees or amounts received through this procedure and process shall be deposited into the Village of Burnham Corporate Fund account.

Section 8. LEGISLATIVE ACT OF HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY

THAT, this Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such Ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or, (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a manner not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any no-preemptive state law that this Ordinance should supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

Section 9. SEVERABILITY

THAT, if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 10. REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

THAT, all Ordinances, Resolutions, Motions or Orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 11. EFFECTIVE UPON PUBLICATION

THAT, this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the Village President (Mayor) and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois.


